

**MINUTES

The Traffic Safety Commission meeting was called to order by Susan Ballard.

- I. Under Agenda Item No. II, Approval of Minutes, March 28, 2011: Faith Waligora made a motion to approve the minutes. Ronnie Martin seconded the motion. The motion prevailed by the following vote:

II. Action Items:

1. Request to Install a “Slow Deaf Child At Play” Sign – A resident from 417 Sheri Lane contacted the city requesting permission to install a “Slow Deaf Child At Play” sign at her own expense. Susan Ballard requested the City Engineer obtain additional information as to the City of Hurst procedure on this type of request. Bob Walker made a motion to table this item for the next meeting. Faith Waligora seconded the motion. The motion prevailed by the following vote

2. Speeding Concern at 700 Thousand Oaks Drive – Mr. Bob Waters of 700 Thousand Oaks Drive spoke to the Commission about the high rate of speed drivers are traveling in front of his home. He is concerned because he has young grandchildren who live in his home. He also explained that Barfield Park attracts many children during little league games. After discussing his concern the Commission determined that it is not all through traffic in Mr. Water’s

neighborhood but is actually neighbors that live near his home. The City Engineer suggested he contact the Police Department and request that the Citizens on Patrol spend some time on the 700 blk. of Thousand Oaks. He suggested that this may deter some of the fast driving. Also, Susan Ballard suggested Mr. Waters write down tag numbers and give them to the Hurst Police Dept. Bob Walker made a motion to table this item for the next meeting. Faith Waligora seconded the motion. The motion prevailed by the following vote:

3. Stop Sign Request at the Intersection of Wheelwood Drive and Woodway Drive – The City Engineer is requesting moving the stop sign at this intersection from north and south to east and west. Because of the 183 Expansion Project, Woodway Drive will be closed off from the frontage road. Susan Ballard requested the City conduct a study to determine if a stop sign is warranted. Nell Delaughter made a motion to table this item for the next meeting. Faith Waligora seconded the motion. The motion prevailed by the following vote:

 - Everything will be at grade level (no raised lanes)
