

**ORDINANCE NO. 1939**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-16(b)(2) OF THE HURST CODE OF ORDINANCES AND ADOPTING THE GUIDELINES SET BY THE TEXAS BUILDING AND PROCUREMENT COMMISSION FOR REASONABLE CHARGES FOR NONSTANDARD COPIES OF PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTED UNDER THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT.**

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to adopt the guidelines set by the Texas Building and Procurement Commission for reasonable charges for nonstandard copies of public records requested under the Texas Public Information Act;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURST, TEXAS:**

**Section 1:** THAT Section 2-16(b)(2) of the Hurst Code of Ordinances be amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-16. Charges for copies.

...

(2) Nonstandard size copies. The charges for nonstandard copies are:

- Diskette \$1.00
- Magnetic tape actual cost
- Data cartridge actual cost
- Tape cartridge actual cost
- Rewritable CD(CD-RW) \$1.00
- Non-rewritable CD(CD-R) \$1.00
- Digital video disc (DVD) \$3.00
- JAZ drive actual cost
- Other electronic media actual cost
- VHS video cassette \$2.50
- Audio cassette \$1.00
- Oversized paper copy (8 ½ x 14 inches, greenbar, bluebar, not including maps and photographs using specialty paper) \$.50
- Specialty Paper  
Mylar copies and photographs (larger than 8 ½ x 14)  
\$4.00 first copy  
\$2.00 each additional
- Maps/plats (larger than 8 ½ x 14) blueprint/blueline paper  
\$3.00 first copy  
\$.75 each additional
